1986 - 1989 - PDG Ben served Rotary in many capacities, as a member of the 4 - member Polio Plus Task Force where he represented the whole of Asia. He helped in the Immunization campaign by handing over \$6 Million Dollars to the Indonesian Government for their Polio Plus Immunization.

1987 - An Instructor (Discussion Leader) at the International Assembly in Nashville, Tennessee. He and spouse Josie represented RI President Mat and Nita Caparas in 2 District Conferences in India in **1987**.

1989 - PDG Ben and Josie represented RI President Royce and Jean Abbey in 3 District Conferences in Australia.

1990 - PDG Ben was elected as Chairman of the Philippine College of Rotary Governors.

1992 - Pres. Raja Saboo asked Ben and Josie to represent him and Usha in a District Conference in Singleton, Australia.

1996 - 1998 - PDG Ben was appointed as the Regional Rotary Foundation Coordinator representing **Zones 6** and part of **7**.

1999 - 2000 - After the \$275,000 funding for the Vitamin A Supplement was approved at the Board Meeting of the RF Board of Trustees right after the RI Convention in Indianapolis in June **1998**, PDG Ben was again asked to coordinate the distribution of Vitamin A supplements to Filipino children. Last November 18, 1998, Angeles City was chosen as the Pilot Area for the launching of this 3-H Vitamin A Supplementation Project of Rotary International where millions of Filipino Children were immunized.

2004 - Training Leader at the International Assembly at Anaheim, Los Angeles, California, U.S.A., under President-Elect Glenn Estess.

Ben is a Charter member of the Rotary Club of Clark Field, Pampanga where he was DGSR. Ben has served Rotary for **40** years (since 1968)
