I have provided a report of Foundation Activities carried out in District 3450 for the period from March 2007 to 31st May 2007 for your information:--

Program

Scholarship

- Both inbound and outbound scholars gave presentation in the District Conference held on 24th and 26th May.
- The production of a DVD on promotion of Ambassadorial Scholarship Program is being in progress. Past Scholar alumni and scholar counselors were interviewed on 23 rd and 24th June in studio. The production was assisted by one of the inbound Scholar from USA, Andy Stoll.

Group Study Exchange Inbound Team (D-1090)

The team arrived on 19 May, 2007. Vocational visits and club presentations were arranged. They stayed three weeks in Hong Kong and one week in Macao. A farewell party was arranged on 14 th June with all the outbound team members.

Matching Grants Projects

The district has a total of 28 Matching Grant club projects. There were 14 projects hosted by the clubs in the district and the other 14 club projects were participated as International partner. The DDF has provided total amount of US\$42,600 to sponsor the Matching Grant club projects.

District Simplified Grant Projects

The district has allocated US\$19,675.00 to 12 projects. All projects have been completed within this year and the final report was sent to TRF by courier on 26 th June. 2007

Polio Plus

In addition to DDF 5,000, the contributions to Polio Plus Partners Program from clubs/Rotarians were in the total amount of US\$78, 500.00
