地區總監現在起可申請成為未來願景計劃的試驗地區。申請者最晚必需在 5 月 15 日的美國中區時間下午 5 點以前回覆到扶輪基金會。相關資料可於社員入口查詢。

該試驗是針對未來願景計劃的新獎助金架構，其簡化程序為兩種的獎助金：扶輪基金會地區獎助金以及扶輪基金會全球獎助金等一個三年期的測試。2010 年月 1 日開始該試驗。

地區有意參與申請需獲得該地區三分之二以上扶輪社的同意。扶輪基金會保管委員會將在提出申請的地區中選出一百個地區。了解更多有關地區遴選及資格相關事宜。

至今九十餘年歷史的扶輪基金會，業已僅為其計畫進行了小幅調整。未來願景計劃—以及那些參與試驗的地區—將促使基金會創造出更有效能及效率的方法，並協助扶輪社員發展出具有卓越影響力，且永續發展的多樣性服務。

District governors may now apply to be a Future Vision Plan pilot district. Applications must be received by The Rotary Foundation no later than **15 May** at 17:00 Central Time. The application can be found on [Member Access](#).

The pilot is a three-year test of the Future Vision Plan's new grant structure, which simplifies the process into two types of grants: [Rotary Foundation District Grants](#) and [Rotary Foundation Global Grants](#). The pilot begins 1 July 2010.

Districts interested in applying must obtain approval from two-thirds of their member clubs. From the applicants, The Foundation Trustees will select up to 100 districts. [Read more about district selection and qualifications.](#)

Throughout its more than 90-year history, the Foundation has made only slight modifications to its programs. The Future Vision Plan -- and those districts that participate in the pilot -- will assist the Foundation in creating a more effective and efficient way to help Rotarians develop diverse projects with greater impact and sustainable outcomes.
